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Course Description

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About Prof. Joyce Ma

Prof. Joyce Ma Lai-chong is the Professor of the Department of Social Work, the Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK). Her specialties and research interests cover the areas of family therapy and multiple family therapy, mental health with recent focuses on eating disorders and attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD).

Prof. Ma is a Clinical Fellow and an Approved Supervisor of the American Association of Marriage and Family Therapy (AAMFT), the founder of the Shengang Family Treatment Centre of Nanshan Hospital in Shenzhen, and the Director of the Family and Group Practice Research Centre of the Department of Social Work, CUHK. She was also appointed as the Co-Clinical Director, Academy of Family Therapy, Hong Kong in January 2013, and the Fellow of the Asian Academy of Family Therapy. In June 2017, she was elected as the President-Elect (2017-2019) of the International Family Therapy Association and will be the President from 2019 to 2021.

Prof. Ma has published five Chinese books and one English book "Anorexia Nervosa and Family Therapy" (2011), and 93 refereed journal articles at international, regional and local venues of significant impact and visibility.
