George S. Everly, Jr., PhD holds the titles of Executive Director of the Resiliency Sciences Institute, Professor of Psychology, NGO Delegate to the United Nations, and Associate Professor of Psychiatry. He is an award-winning author and researcher. Professor Everly is one of the "founding fathers" of the field of disaster mental health. He is the author of over 20 textbooks and 100 professional papers. Having coined the term "psychotraumatology" in the early 1990s, he turned his focus from treatment to prevention. He developed the Johns Hopkins' RAPID model of Psychological First Aid (PFA). His current areas of research are human resilience after crisis and disaster and resilient leadership. His latest books are The Resilient Child (2009), Resilient Leadership (2010), and Fostering Human Resilience after Crisis and Disaster (2011).
