Professor John Campbell is Professor of Geriatric Medicine at the Dunedin School of Medicine, Otago, New Zealand and a consultant physician at Dunedin Hospital. He was Dean of the Otago Medical School from 1995 until 2005 and Chair of the Medical Council of New Zealand from 2003 until 2010. He was an external advisor to the Hong Kong Hospital Authority Elderly People Service Plan Taskforce in 2010. He has a particular interest in the community provision of services for older people and in the maintenance of professional standards. His main research has been in the field of fall and fracture prevention in older people.
