Ms Eva Tsui is the Chief Manager of Statistics and Workforce Planning Department, Hospital Authority Head Office. Currently she leads the department to provide statistical information and perform modeling to facilitate strategic planning, service review, research and informed decision making; and to synthesize and crystallize clinical and administrative data into strategic information.

Since joining the Hospital Authority (HA) in 1994, she has spearheaded many statistical projects and developments. She developed the risk prediction model to predict the probability of elderly emergency admission, which has now been automated and used as a daily tool to screen out high-risk elderly patients for recruitment into the Community Health Call Centre and Integrated Care Management programme. She has also established an integrated service demand and manpower requirement projection model which currently forms a common basis for service, facility and workforce planning within HA.

Ms Tsui has a BSoc.Sc. in Economics and a MSoc.Sc. in Applied Statistics from the University of Hong Kong. She obtained the Best Oral Presentation Award for Service Priorities and Programmes at HA Convention 2007; and the Best Poster Award at HA Convention 2006 and 2007 respectively.
