Relationship Centered Care Model:

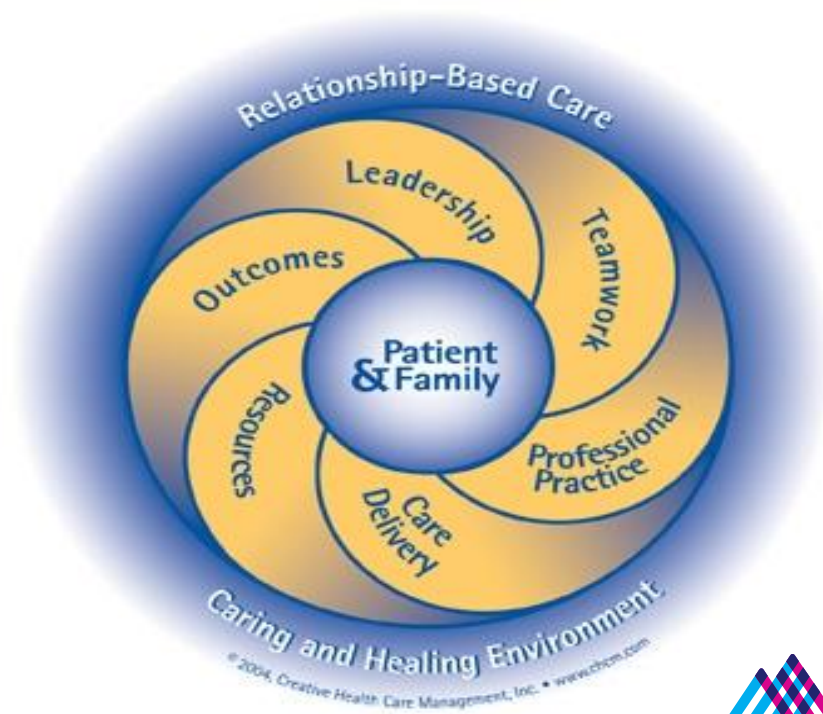
Care of patients/families

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Evaluating Results of the PPM Implementation

Linkages between caring behaviors and patient satisfaction
- Cross-national Caring Study: Comparing US and Irish nurses caring behaviors



Current Scholarship Projects

Expansion of therapeutic intervention study with geriatric patients throughout the hospital



Current Scholarship Projects

Falls assessment among psychiatric patients, and geropsychiatric patients



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Current Scholarship Projects

Doctoral student/nurse leader initiatives focused on integration of theoretical perspectives in professional practice, evaluation of practice interventions to increase patient satisfaction, and characteristics of nurse leaders (e.g. empowerment among nurse managers)

Recommendations for an action-oriented blueprint for the future of nursing

IOM Report on the Future of Nursing

- Nurses should practice to the full extent of their education and training.
- Nurses should achieve higher levels of education and training through an improved education system that promotes seamless academic progression.
- Nurses should be full partners, with physicians and other health care professionals, in redesigning health care in the United States.
- Effective workforce planning and policy making require better data collection and information infrastructure.
