Objective


- A double effect to enhance and improve patient safety and quality of care
- Early detection of patient's risk and needs
- Give patient a heightened sense of security
- Recognize the work done by the supporting staff
- Promote a caring and supportive culture within the team
- Build up the high safety and quality culture

Result (12/2012-01/2013)

- Fall prevention: 64 times
- Found patient complaint of pain: 20 times
- Stop treatment disruption: 67 times
- Assist patient in positioning: 45 times
- Assist patient for toileting: 36 times
- Response to patient's personal needs: 103 times
- Found instrument alarm: 55 times
- Miscellaneous: 10 times
- Report to Nurse: 98 times
