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Background & Methodology

Aims of service:

- Optimize quality use of drugs
- Enhance medication safety
- Improve patient care

Pharmacist interventions:

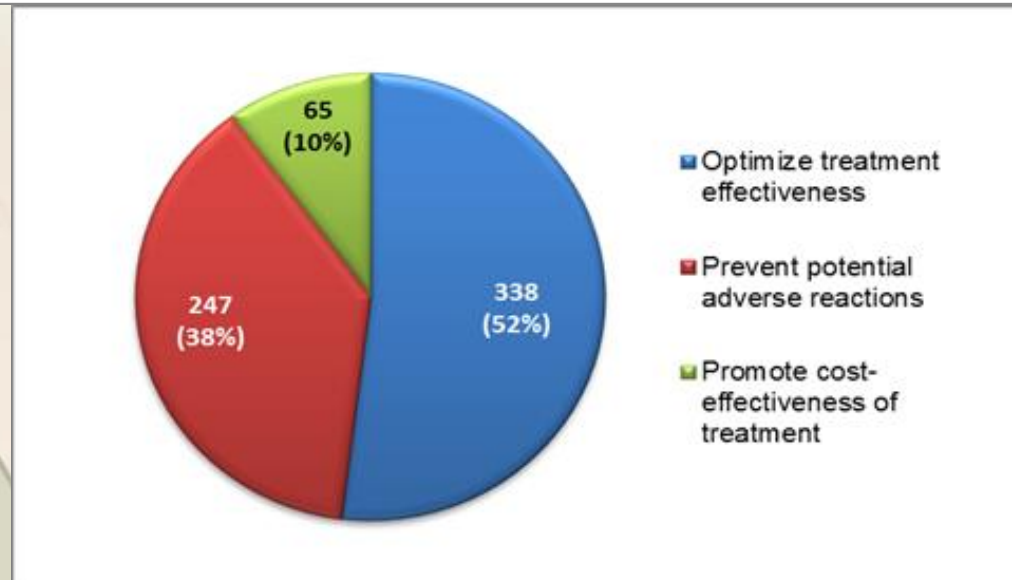
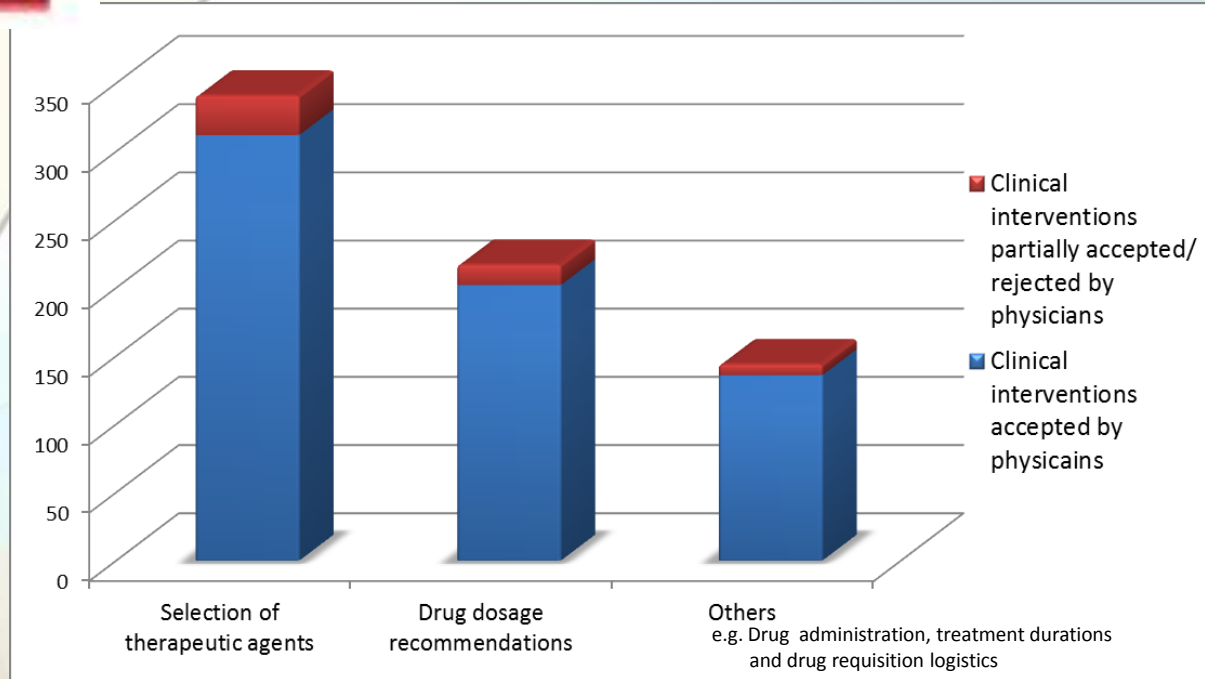
- Participate in the daily clinical rounds
- Review pharmaceutical plans and drug prescriptions
- Prepare chemotherapy orders

Objective & methodology :

- Establish & evaluate roles of Clinical Pharmacist in Haematology wards
- Descriptive & quantitative¹ analysis of clinical interventions



Results



- Evaluation period : 9 months
- 650 clinical interventions/ recommendations made
- Acceptance rate: 92%
- 148 drug information enquiries handled
- 48 chemotherapy treatment orders prepared
- Physicians rated service as 'excellent' or 'good'
