Hospital Authority Convention 2018

I. Introduction

Since 1993, the Hong Kong Hospital Authority has been organising a convention every year to promote sharing of experience among healthcare professionals. Over 5,300 clinicians and healthcare professionals, including staff of the Hospital Authority and healthcare managers and executives from Mainland China, Hong Kong and overseas, attended the annual Convention held in May 2017.

The scientific programme of the Hospital Authority Convention 2018 will focus on the HA's core values, viz. "People-centred Care 以人為先","Professional Service 專業為本","Committed Staff 敬業樂業" and "Teamwork 群策群力". The Convention aims to promote the sharing of knowledge and experience on clinical advances and approaches to modern healthcare service, and facilitates exploration and discussion of contemporary concepts among healthcare professionals and stakeholders.


