Discharge advice after conscious sedation in Accident & Emergency Department:

- The patient is strongly advised to go home and take care by another responsible adult
- Analgesic is usually prescribed and should be taken as instructed
- In case of emergency, please dial 999 and call an ambulance
- For the next 12- 24 hours, patients must not:
 - return to work;
 - drive a car or other vehicle;
 - consume alcohol;
 - operate machinery (including kitchen equipment);
 - climb heights (e.g. ladders, scaffolding) or other hard exercise;
 - be in charge of other people;
 - make important decisions (e.g. signing legal documents).
