Use of Mobile Phones


Mobile phones are prohibited in areas with large number of highly sensitive medical equipment. For other areas, visitors should keep mobile phones at least one metre away from medical equipment.

- New patients must be referred by general outpatient clinics, private doctors or accident and emergency departments.
- Please bring along a valid doctor's referral letter, identification documents and proof of residential address to the respective specialist clinics for making appointment.
- On the day of consultation, please pay at the shroff on G/F, North Wing, Li Ka Shing Specialist Outpatient Clinics, then submit the appointment slip, consultation card and other related documents to the respective clinics.
