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

Where do we stand

 A pre-eminent healthcare centre in the region with high professional and ethical standard



 Strong commitment of Government to invest in healthcare

Where do we stand

- Surging service demand brought about by an ageing and growing population
- Increasing medical costs brought about by medical inflation and new technology
- Imbalance between public and private sector
- Call for enhancing transparency, in particular the private sector

What we are doing - Public healthcare as the safety net

- The public healthcare system as an equitable and accessible safety net for the population as a whole, with four target services areas and population groups -
 - (a) acute and emergency care;
 - (b) healthcare or medical care for low-income and under-privileged groups;
 - (c) illnesses that entail high cost, advanced technology and multi-disciplinary professional team work; and
 - (d) training of healthcare professionals




- Provide alternative choice to public healthcare
- Enhance long-term sustainability of our healthcare system
- Protection Scheme (HPS): Standardise and regulate voluntary private health insurance by legislation for consumer protection



What we are doing - Enhancing primary care

- Developed Reference framework for diabetes and hypertension care in primary care settings
- Published doctor and dentist sub-directories of the Primary Care Directory
- First purpose-built Community Health Centre will be established in first half of 2012
- Launched a territory-wide "Primary Care Campaign"
