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Reform of Psychiatric General Adult Day Hospital (GADH)

Background

- Clients expressed boring, did not fully understand the reasons of being referred to GADH
- Clients needed to attend daily
- Clients felt frustration for keeping in the boundary of hospital again
- Average occupancy rate on the low side

Reform of Psychiatric GADH

Objectives

- Enhance full utilization of the day hospital
- Active involvement of clients in their own care planning
- > Enhance clients engagement
- Empower clients to take an active role in own recovery plan

Reform of Psychiatric GADH

Progress

- Service feedbacks were collected from service users
- Referral forms re-designed to highlight the goal to GADH



- Multi-disciplinary "My Care Plan", Chinese version, is adopted
- Clients' attendance depends on the care plan agreed by clients and staff
- Key Performance Indicator (KPI) was established with service users involvement

Reform of Psychiatric GADH

Result and Outcome

Both clients & staff have clear treatment goals



- Better adherence to their own care plans
- ➤ Day hospital coined "步康園" by the clients
- Staff put on private clothing to minimize the feeling of hospitalization
- Admission rate increased 16%; discharge rate increased 22%
- Regular KPI for service evaluation
