- Simulation training versus Combined training
- Successful completion rate of scenarios and comments were analyzed



Results

- I0 sessions
- 53 Emergency staffs



-11 Physicians (28.9%) & 42 Nurses (55.3%)

Results	Session I to 5 (Simulation)	Session 6 to 10 (Simulation with element of CRM)
Comments	Knowledge Skill-based	Communication Teamwork Knowledge Skill -based
Successful completion rate of scenarios (P=0.06)	70% (7/10)	100% (10/10)



Conclusions

- Simulation training with the element of Crew Resource Management is useful and practical
- Promote communication and teamwork
- Help to understand strengths and weaknesses
- Enhance staffs to face the challenges in real life situations
