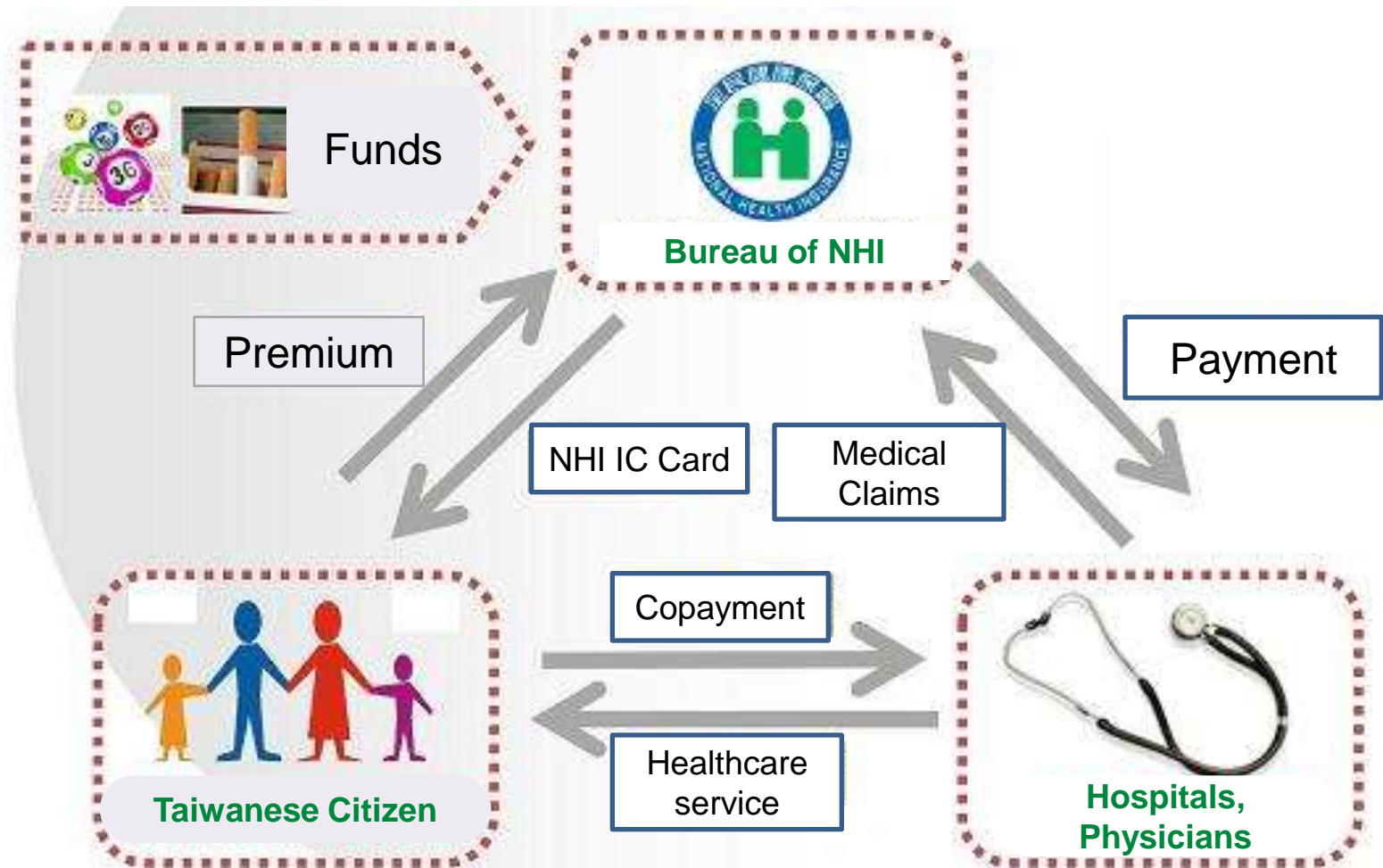

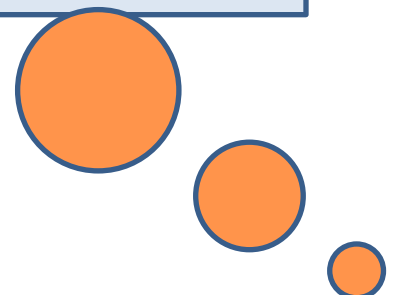
**Taiwan :** Nurse grade (N, N1, N2, N3, N4) Starting from N, they compulsory to do case study / project / nursing research for advancing the grade.

**Specialty training in N2.**

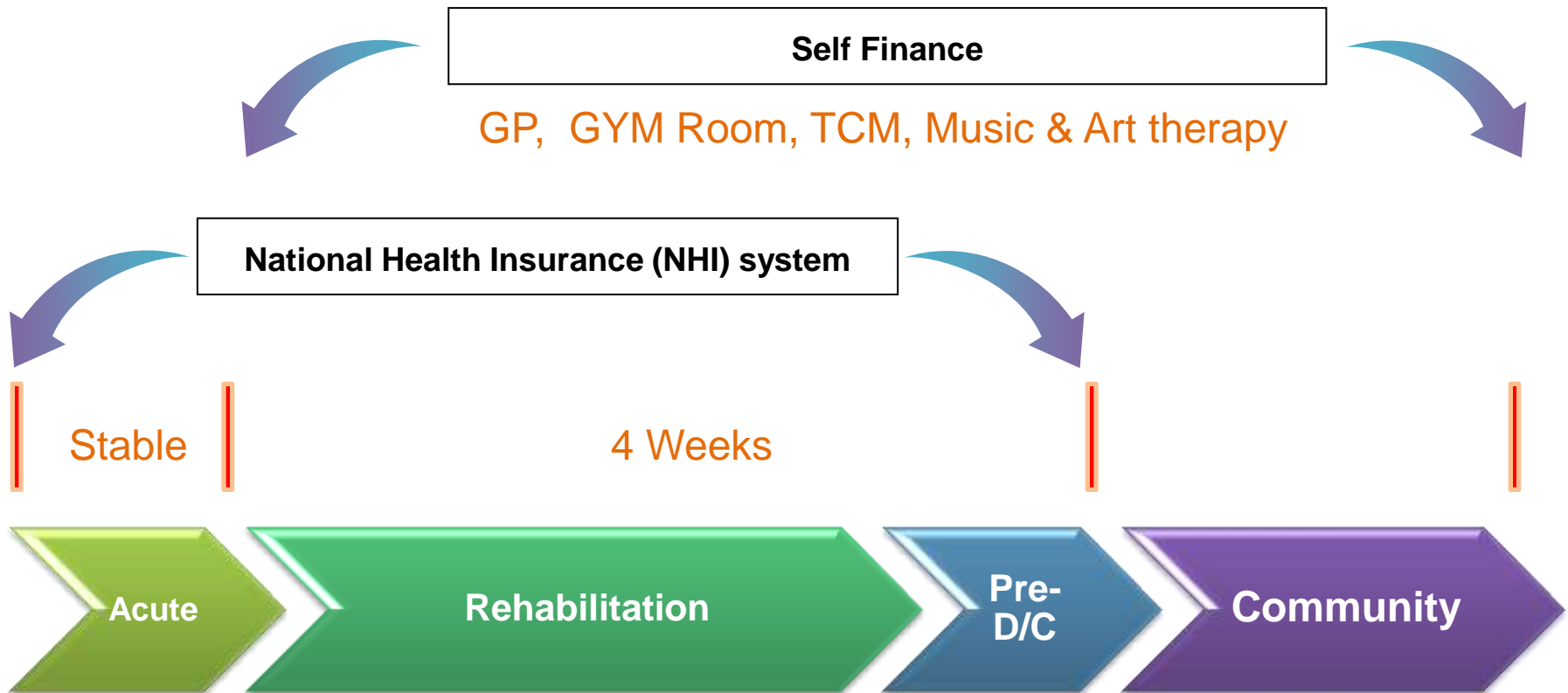
**Hong Kong :** In general, nurses need to study 45 CNE credits for every 3 years but not compulsory. From this year, HK Academy of Nursing required fellow membership 60 CNE which included 45 specialty related CNE for every 3 years.

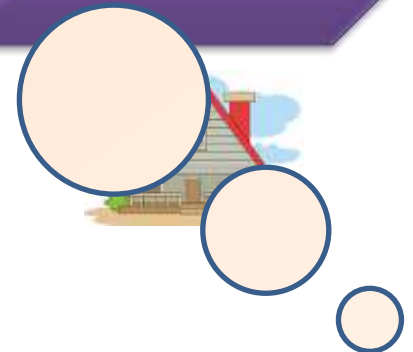
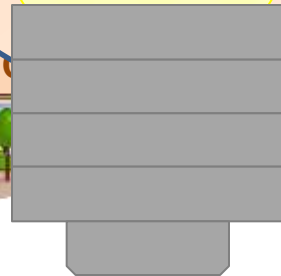
**Taiwan :** Main caregivers perform all the bedside activities, and they receive training from different departments and attend various training sessions. Nurses receive education, and they may visit patients before hospital admission.

**Enhance the caregivers competency in performing nursing care.**

**Hong Kong :** Visiting nurses are the main caregivers. They receive education, and they work with MSW.

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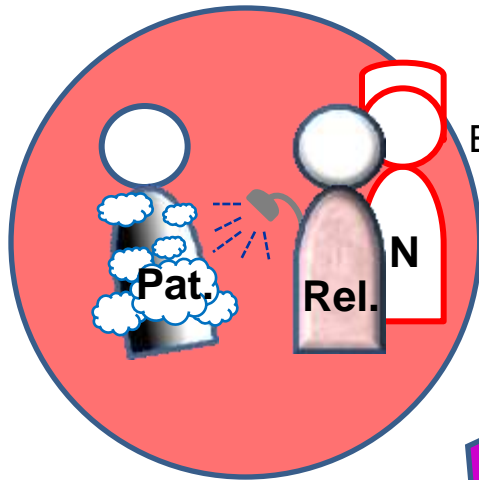

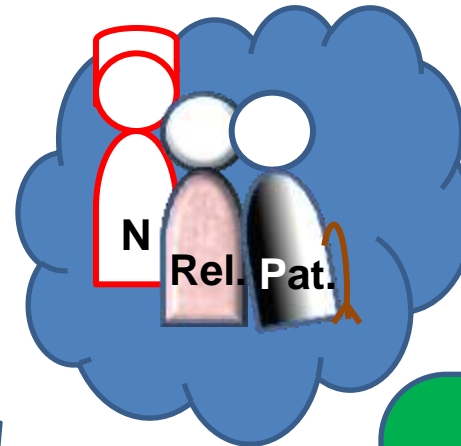
# Empowerment of Stroke Patient Caregiver through Partnership Programme

## Objective

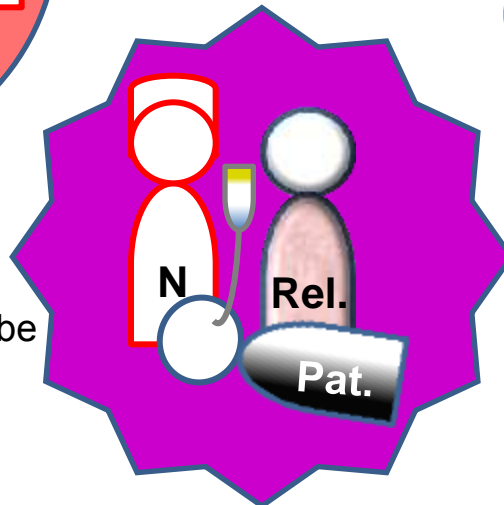
1. To strengthen caregivers' competency in caring stroke patients.

4. To facilitate caregivers to have more hands on experience in caring stroke patients before discharge through allowing flexible visiting hour.



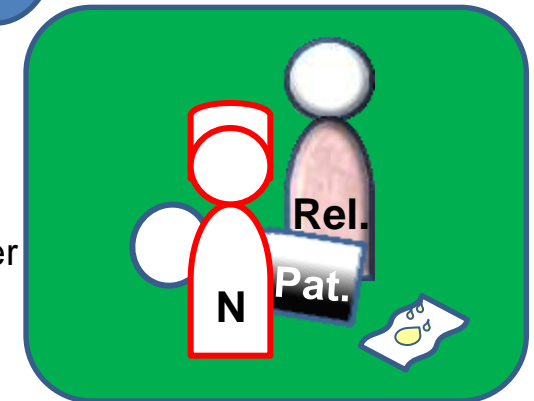
