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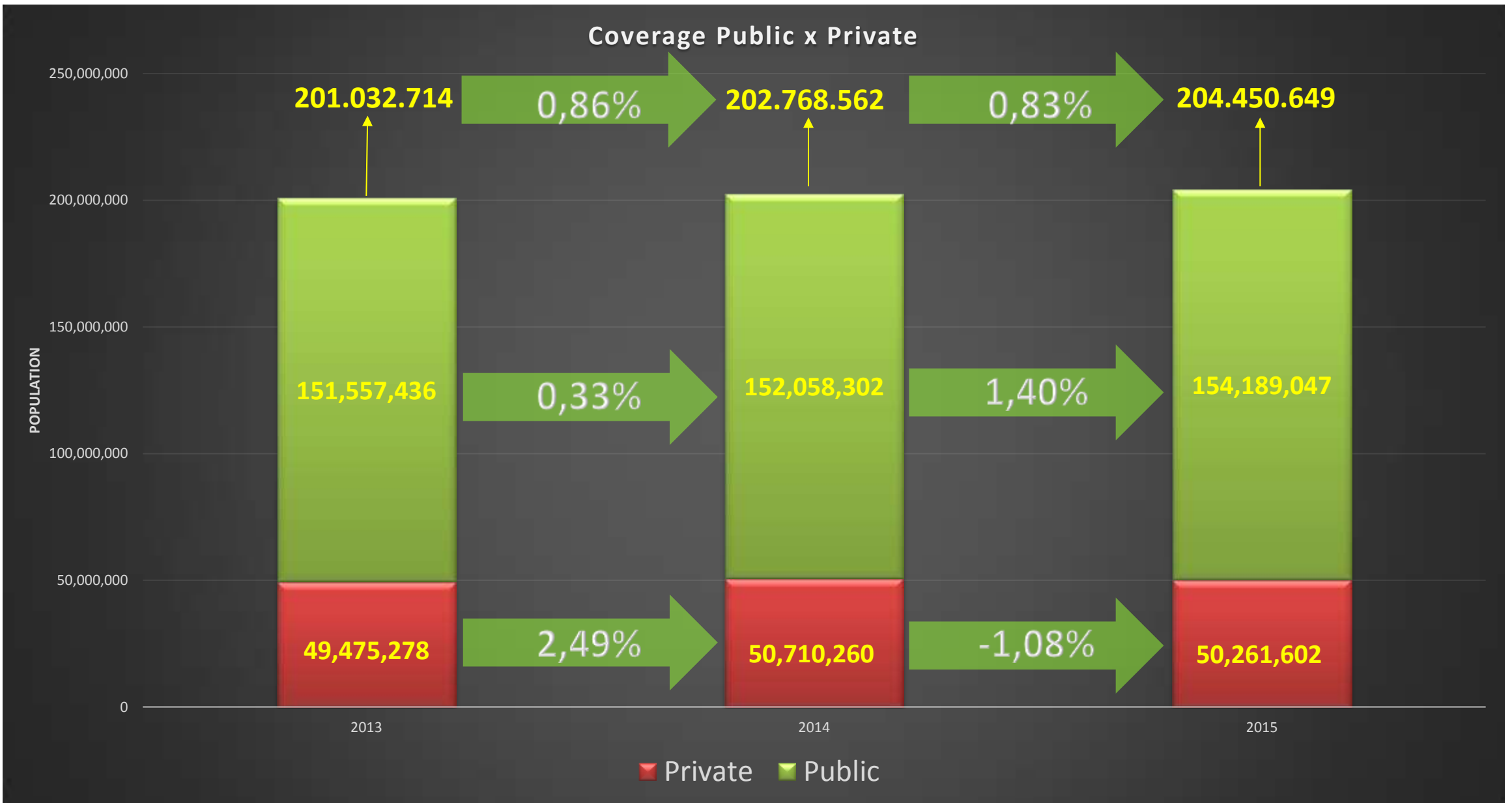

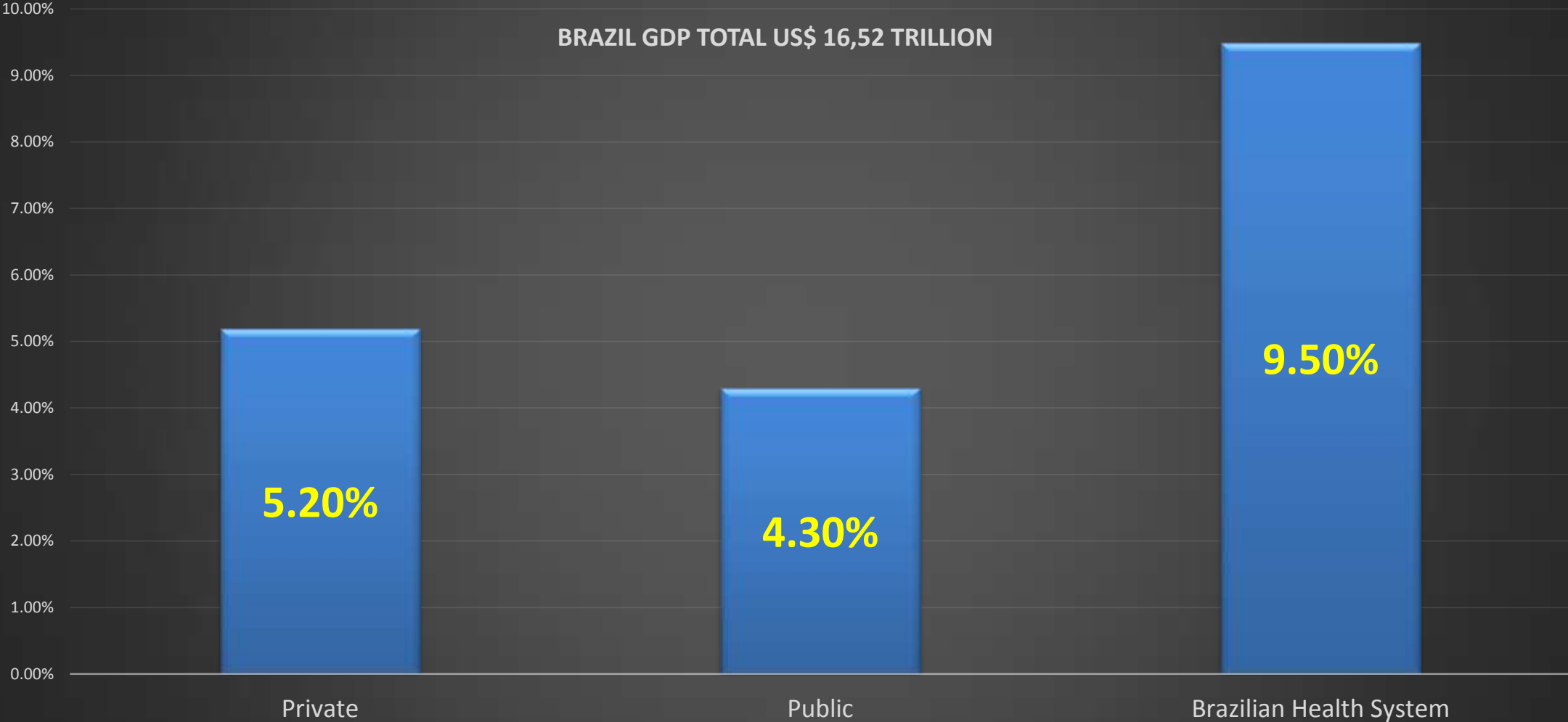

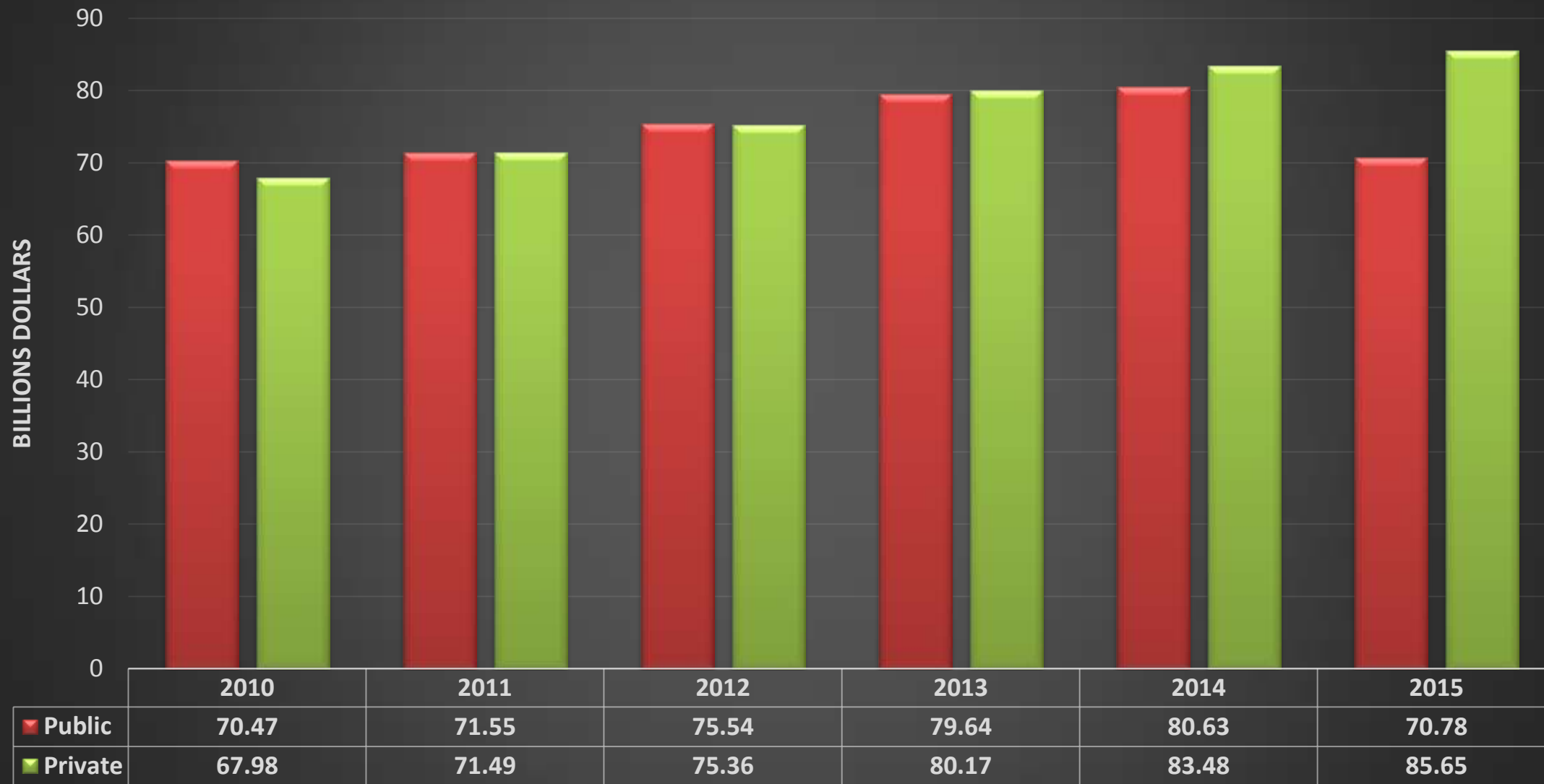

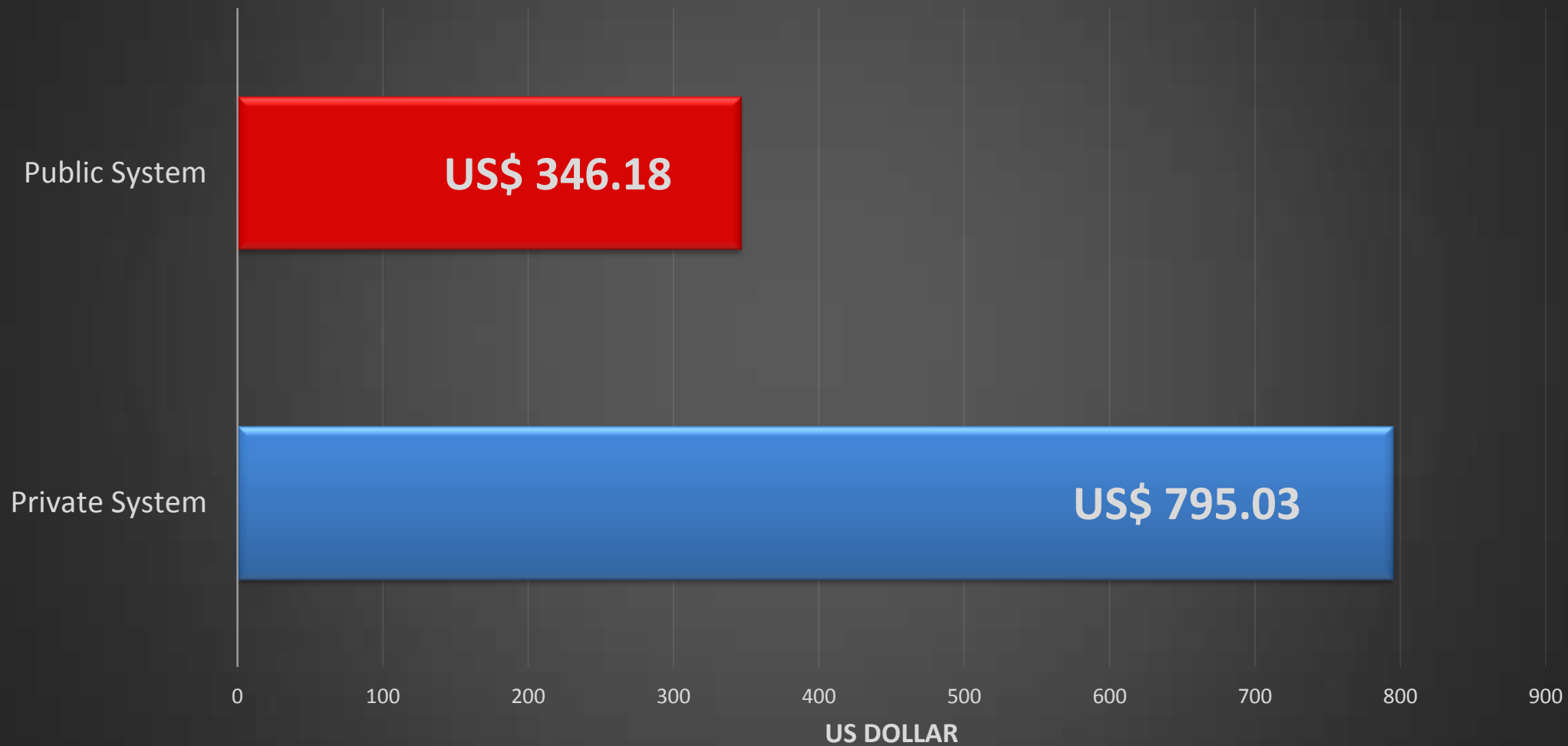

TOTAL SPENDING - PUBLIC x PRIVATE

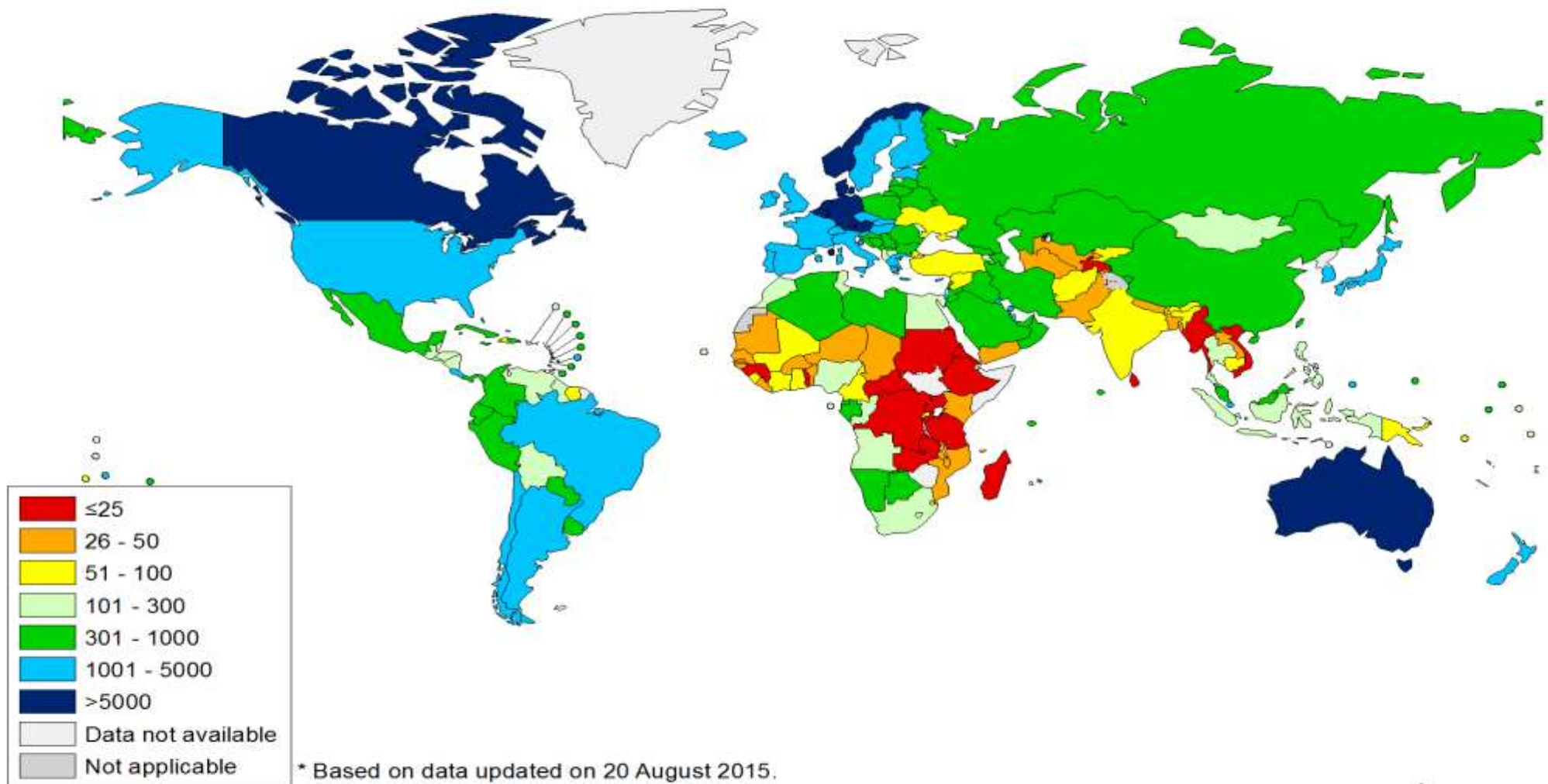


Spend per capita - Public x Private - 2015



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Per capita total expenditure on health at average exchange rate (US\$), 2013 *



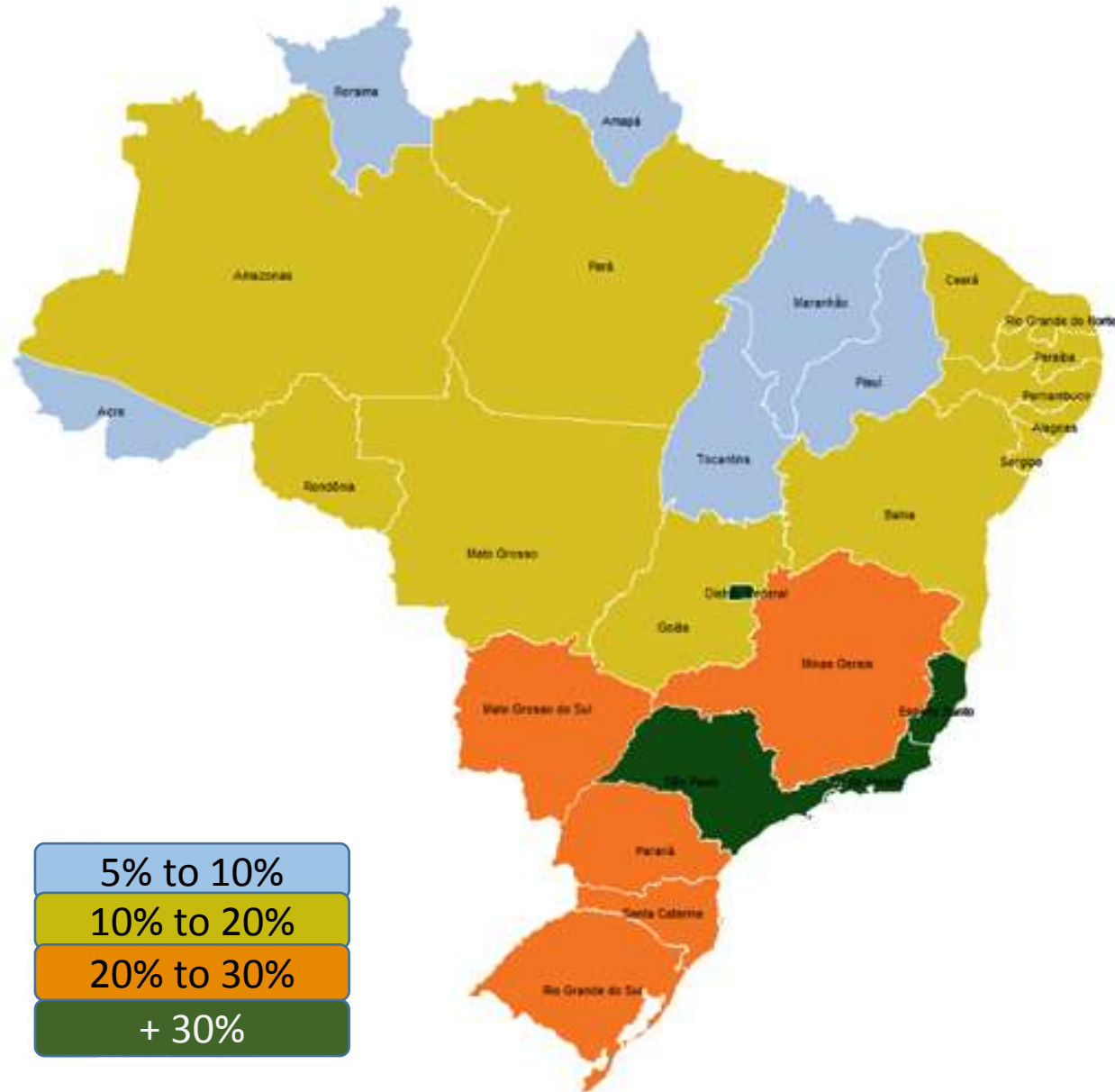

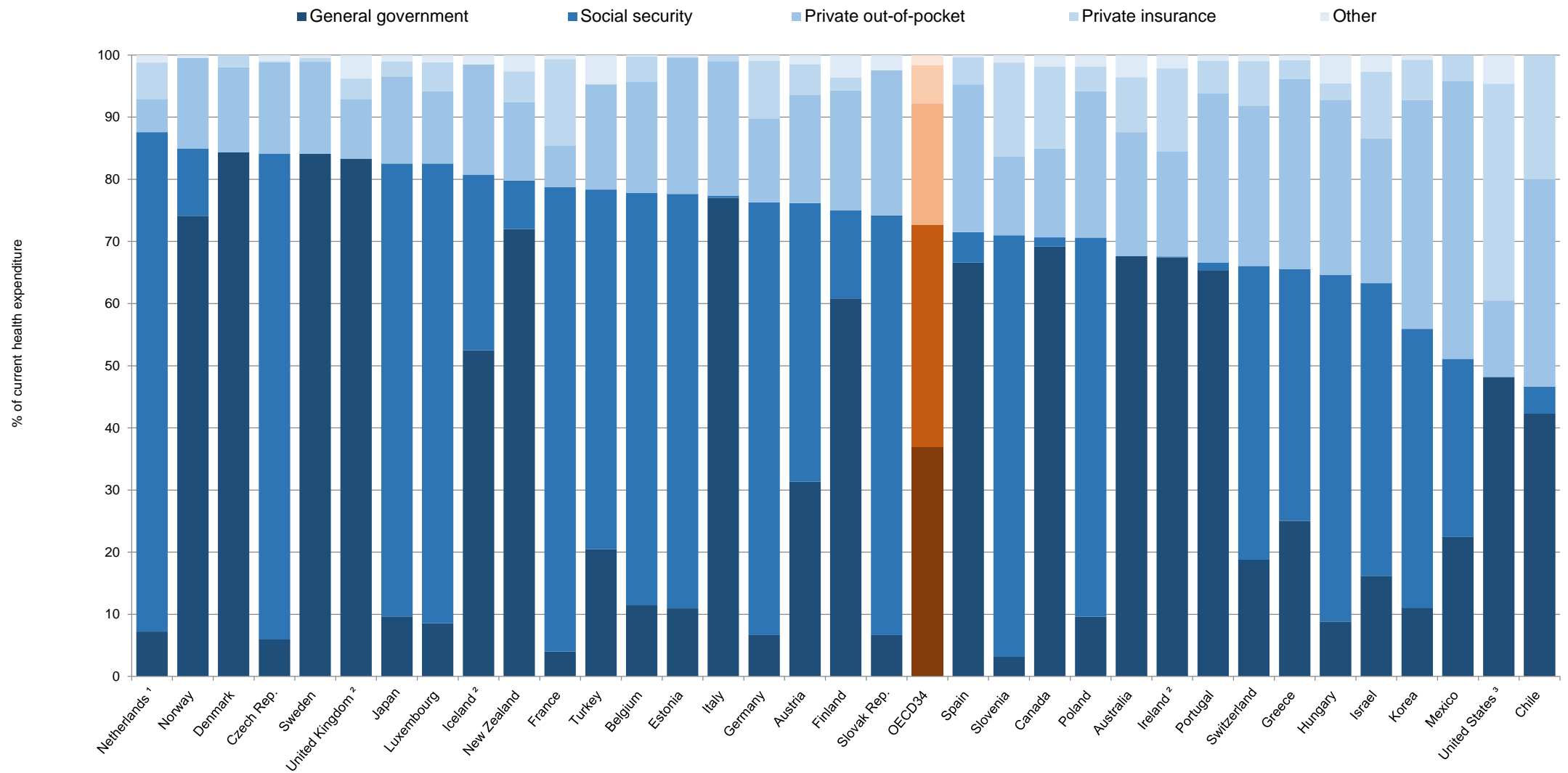
