Advanced Nursing Practice and Advanced Practice Nursing (APN) are equally important in today's healthcare marketplace. In the United States (US), Advanced Practice Nursing is a role, for the Nurse Practitioner, the Clinical Nurse Specialist, the Nurse Midwife, and the Nurse Anesthetist. These 4 roles for Advanced Practice Nurses, are unified under this umbrella, which has helped to provide consistency in their educational requirements, licensure, and credentialing. This LACE model of integration has helped shape the practice both in primary, acute and specialty care.
