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Consultation and Liaison Service

Consultation and Liaison Team is developed in 1994 and service is further extended to peri-natal and postnatal women in 2005 and; their children in 2008. Multi-disciplinary approach and staff member includes: medical officers, clinical psychologists, and psychiatric nurses.

Service Aims

- Provide psychiatric assessment and care to those people experiencing acute psychiatric problems, mood disturbance and behavior disorder
- Refer people to receive appropriate treatment at various service units e.g. special out-patient department or other mental health programmes
- Arrange psychiatric admission for people with acute need of psychiatric treatment / care.
- Support Medical & Health Department programme, early assessment for child from age 0-5 is provided to eliminate the rate of behavior or developmental problem in his later developmental stage
- Promote mental health knowledge to prei-natal and post-natal woman and her family

Service groups

Residents of Tung Chung, Kwai Chung, Tsuen Wan, Tsing Yi and Wong Tai Sin

Service Characteristics

1. Provides consultation and liaison service to service users of accident and emergency department and admitted cases of general hospitals.

2. Provides acute emergency care at accident and emergency department (AED) by advanced practice nurse (psychiatric) with special training.

3. Provides early assessment to child with age 0-5 at Maternal & Child Health Centres of Kwai Chung, Tsuen Wan, Tsing Yi and Wong Tai Sin.

4. Operates Out-patient Department Services with various service units

- i. Mental Health Psychological Service at Caritas Medical Centres - provides mental health treatment

- ii. Perinatal Clinic at Maternal & Child Health Centres - provides assessment and counseling service to those pregnant woman and her spouse

- iii. Nurse Clinic at Blk. K / PMH - provides mental health treatment for service users of Perinatal/Post-natal Clinics who presents mood disturbance.

5. Organize educational talk to pregnant woman and her family at Perinatal Clinic.
