

The hospital has not undergone any major renovation or refurbishment since it opened. Conditions of facilities and physical setting have become outdated and lack the capability to facilitate delivery of modern psychiatric care and training of professionals. In the redevelopment, our hospital will focus on the patient's journey to recovery and ensure that each step is carefully designed and patient-centred. The vision is that a therapeutic village campus, where patients with a range of mental disorders can live, receive treatment, visit and work with staff, NGO and volunteers, while recovering and moving towards re-integration with mainstream society.

There will be simulation of real life in the environment, offering various choices of activity spaces while retaining a feeling of personal safety, security and fundamental dignity. Separation of inpatient areas for adults, adolescents and children will be expressed in a variety of identifiable residential design form. Green external space and integration with nature will be an essential provision throughout the campus.
