Update on the Queen Mary Hospital Redevelopment, Phase 1

Purpose

This paper aims to brief members on the latest progress of the Queen Mary Hospital (QMH) Redevelopment, phase 1.

Progress Update

A. Senior Staff Quarters (SSQ) Conversion Works

- 1. The SSQ conversion and the associated works commenced on 28 July 2014, they are generally on schedule. The widening and improvement works for Road B were completed in early August 2015.
- 2. In response to the concerns raised by members of the Southern District Council during an on-site inspection after the fatal traffic accident in June 2015, additional temporary traffic signs indicating "no entry for vehicles over three tonnes" were put up by QMH at both ends of the steep road at the southern end of the hospital campus to enhance road safety. Permanent traffic signs have subsequently been installed on 4 September 2015.
